## **Approval of Minutes:**

### Friends of Katie Lamb Public Library Report (FOKLPL):

- Elected new officers for 2025
  - o Only change Karen Bradford is the new Vice President
  - o Current membership- 65 members
    - Discussed changing from January-December to a rolling membership. This was passed as a group.
    - Monthly renewal letters will be sent as anniversaries of membership come up.
    - \$40 Walmart gift card given to each staff person for staff appreciation. (\$360 total) Reviewed increasing for this year.
  - New event
    - Children's Author Fair in the Fall. Created \$500 in their budget for this event. This month's meeting will discuss the event.
  - o 2025 Local Author Series
    - 4 author series events starting in June.
      - Four authors have been selected for June, July, August, and September
  - Fundraising Opportunities

- The Pop-Up Library will be situated in the East Room at City Hall, featuring a curated selection of books, including children's literature, new releases, limited checkout options, and computer access.

## • Renovation Discussion

- O What is the most significant changes to expect:
  - Children's section moving to the left side where current stacks are located.
  - Space where children's section occupies today will be utilized to create study spaces and dedicated computer spacing.
  - Circulation desk will move and be made smaller to allow seating where current circulation desk is currently.
  - Southern University has offered guidance on services and spaces that patrons of the library may use during the construction timeline.

## **Collegedale Commission Report**

- Library renovations approved.
  - o 5 bids put in by contractors on the renovations.
    - 1 of the 5 was incomplete. The other 4 contractors were reviewed to determine who would fit the work for the best budget and timeline.
    - Architect assisted with reviewing the bids to provide guidance based on the established renovations.
  - Storage discussions to ensure library collection is well covered while in storage for the duration of the renovations.
- Imagination Station playground officially re-opened.
- Storm Safety Day at the Commons was very successful. Requested to be an annual event.
  - Recommended that the Friends look to fundraise or raise awareness at the next event.

- New parking lot is in process of being striped. Will be open soon.
- The Collegedale School Resource Officer interested in reading to the children at the library.
- TDOT Aeronautic education grants likely to approve grants that are requested for STEM kits for aviation. Director expressed interest in working with the library to promote STEM and aviation.
  - o Application deadline is May 15th.
